

ST JOHNS COUNTY EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 2017- 2

AN EMERGENCY ORDER RESCINDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY EMERGENCY ORDER 2016-4, WHICH CREATED A TEMPORARY NO WAKE ZONE WITHIN THE INTRACOASTAL WATERWAY BETWEEN GREEN CHANNEL MARKERS 83A AND 85.

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Florida issued Executive Order No. 2016-230 declaring a State of Emergency in all Florida Counties pertaining to Hurricane Matthew and Executive Order Nos. 2016-274, 2017-16, and 2017-67 extending the State of Emergency; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County Emergency Proclamation 2016-2 declared a state of local emergency within St. Johns County pursuant to Chapter 252, Florida Statutes and St. Johns County Ordinance No. 1994-25, as amended, because of the severe threat posed by Hurricane Matthew to St. Johns County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County Emergency Proclamations 2016-3, 2016-4, 2016-5, 2016-6, and 2016-7 extended the state of local emergency in order for the County to effectively respond to emergency conditions and mitigate disaster effects within St. Johns County; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the emergency powers granted pursuant to Chapter 252, Florida Statutes, and St. Johns County Ordinance 1994-25, as amended, the County Administrator issued Emergency Order 2016-4, creating a temporary idle speed, no wake boating restricted area within the Intracoastal Waterway between Green Channel Markers 83A and 85; and


WHEREAS, Emergency Order 2016-4 remains in effect until the expiration of Executive Order 2016-230, including any extension thereof; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County Emergency Management has determined that there is no longer a need to continue the temporary idle speed, no wake boating restricted area established by Emergency Order 2016-4 and that Emergency Order 2016-4 should be rescinded.

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the emergency power vested in the St. Johns County Board of Commissioners pursuant to Chapter 252, Florida Statutes, and St. Johns County Ordinance No. 1994-25, as amended, St. Johns County Emergency Order 2016-4, as revised, is hereby rescinded.
