

ST. JOHNS COUNTY EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 2019- 6

**AN EMERGENCY ORDER INSTATING A MANDATORY
CURFEW BETWEEN 8PM AND 6AM IN CERTAIN PORTIONS
OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY**

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Florida has issued Executive Order No. 19-190 declaring a State of Emergency in all Florida Counties pertaining to Hurricane Dorian; and

WHEREAS, a state of local emergency has been declared, pursuant to Chapter 252, Florida Statutes and St. Johns County Ordinance No. 2019-40, because of the severe threat that Hurricane Dorian poses to St. Johns County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, to safeguard areas ordered evacuated by St. Johns County Emergency Order No. 2019-4, a mandatory curfew has been requested and recommended by competent law enforcement authority,

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the emergency power vested in the County pursuant to Chapter 252, Florida Statutes, and St. Johns County Ordinance No. 2019-40, it is hereby ordered that all persons in the following portions and elements of St. Johns County, Florida shall be subject to a mandatory curfew between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m. until the local state of emergency expires, or as otherwise provided by cancellation or revision of this order:

- (1) all areas within Evacuation Zones A and B
- (2) all areas within the jurisdiction of the City of St. Augustine Beach
- (3) all areas within the jurisdiction of the City of St. Augustine
- (4) all areas within "Hastings"
- (5) all areas within Flagler Estates

The Hurricane Dorian Evacuation Zone Map is attached hereto, and incorporated herein.

Any person in the areas described above (with the exception of authorized emergency services personnel and those people actively evacuating to safety) who is not in a building authorized for that person during the curfew period shall be deemed in violation of this Order.


Any person who fails to comply with this Order is guilty of a misdemeanor of the second degree, and subject to punishment in accordance with applicable Florida law.
