

ST. JOHNS COUNTY EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 2019-7

**AN EMERGENCY ORDER BY THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR
ISSUED PURSUANT TO SECTION 252.46, FLORIDA STATUTES AND
ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2019-40, EXTENDING THE
COUNTY CLOSURE.**

WHEREAS, in light of the threat posed by Hurricane Dorian, the Governor of the State of Florida has issued Executive Order No. 19-190, declaring a State of Emergency for all Florida Counties, including St. Johns County (County); and

WHEREAS, a state of local emergency has been declared, pursuant to Chapter 252, Florida Statutes and St. Johns Ordinance No. 2019-40, because of the severe threat that Hurricane Dorian poses to the County; and

WHEREAS, in efforts to preserve public health and safety, the County Administrator issued EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 3, closing County offices on Tuesday, September 3, 2019 and Wednesday, September 4, 2019 (County Closure); and


WHEREAS, because Hurricane Dorian continues to pose a severe threat to the County, the County Administrator deems it reasonable to extend the County Closure to include Thursday, September 5, 2019.


NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the power vested in the County Administrator pursuant to section 252.46, Florida Statutes and St. Johns County Ordinance 2019-40, the following is hereby ordered:

1. The County Closure is hereby extended through and until the end of business on Thursday, September 5, 2019.
2. The rules promulgated regarding the emergency disaster pay plan are hereby retained, ratified and continued for the duration of the County Closure, as extended.
