

ST JOHNS COUNTY EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 2019- 9
AN EMERGENCY ORDER RESCINDING THE MANDATORY CURFEW PERTAINING TO
CERTAIN PORTIONS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY.

WHEREAS, St. Johns County Emergency Order No. 2019-5 implemented a mandatory curfew in certain areas of St. Johns County, to wit:

- (1) all of Evacuation Zones A and B
- (2) all areas within the jurisdiction of the City of St. Augustine Beach
- (3) all areas within the jurisdiction of the City of St. Augustine
- (4) all areas within "Hastings"
- (5) all areas within Flagler Estates
- (6) all residents living in boats, RVs, and mobile homes; and

WHEREAS, storm conditions have receded sufficiently to lift the mandatory curfew at this time.

NOW THEREFORE, the mandatory curfew pertaining to certain portions of St. Johns County implemented through St. Johns County Emergency Order No. 2019-5 is hereby rescinded, effective 3pm today.
