

ST. JOHNS COUNTY EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 2022- 2

**AN EMERGENCY ORDER INSTATING A MANDATORY
EVACUATION OF CERTAIN PORTIONS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY**

WHEREAS, the Governor of the state of Florida has issued Executive Order No. 22-218 declaring a State of Emergency in certain Florida Counties pertaining to Tropical Depression Nine, now known as Hurricane Ian; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of the state of Florida has issued Executive Order No. 22-219, amending Executive Order No. 22-218 by declaring a State of Emergency for the entire state of Florida; and

WHEREAS, a state of local emergency has been declared, pursuant to Chapter 252, Florida Statutes and St. Johns County Ordinance No. 2021-4, because of the severe threat that Hurricane Ian poses to St. Johns County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, because of the potential for Hurricane Ian to cause excessive rainfall, flooding, high tides, and strong winds that may create a serious threat to life and critical infrastructure, timely precautions must be taken to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of St. Johns County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the St. Johns County Board of Commissioners, through its authorized County designee, mandates that certain portions and elements of St. Johns County be evacuated by all persons.

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the emergency power vested in the St. Johns County Board of Commissioners pursuant to Chapter 252, Florida Statutes, and St. Johns County Ordinance No. 2021-4, it is hereby ordered that, effective at 6:00 a.m. on Wednesday, September 28, 2022, all persons in the following portions and elements of St. Johns County, Florida shall evacuate:

- (1) all of Evacuation Zone A;
- (2) parts of Evacuation Zone B, as depicted on the attached map;
- (3) parts of Evacuation Zone F, as depicted on the attached map; and
- (4) all persons living in or on a boat, mobile home, recreational vehicle, camper or other similar conveyance.

This Order shall stay in effect until rescinded. Any person (with the exception of authorized emergency services personnel) who fails to comply with this Order is guilty of a misdemeanor of the second degree, and subject to punishment in accordance with applicable Florida law.

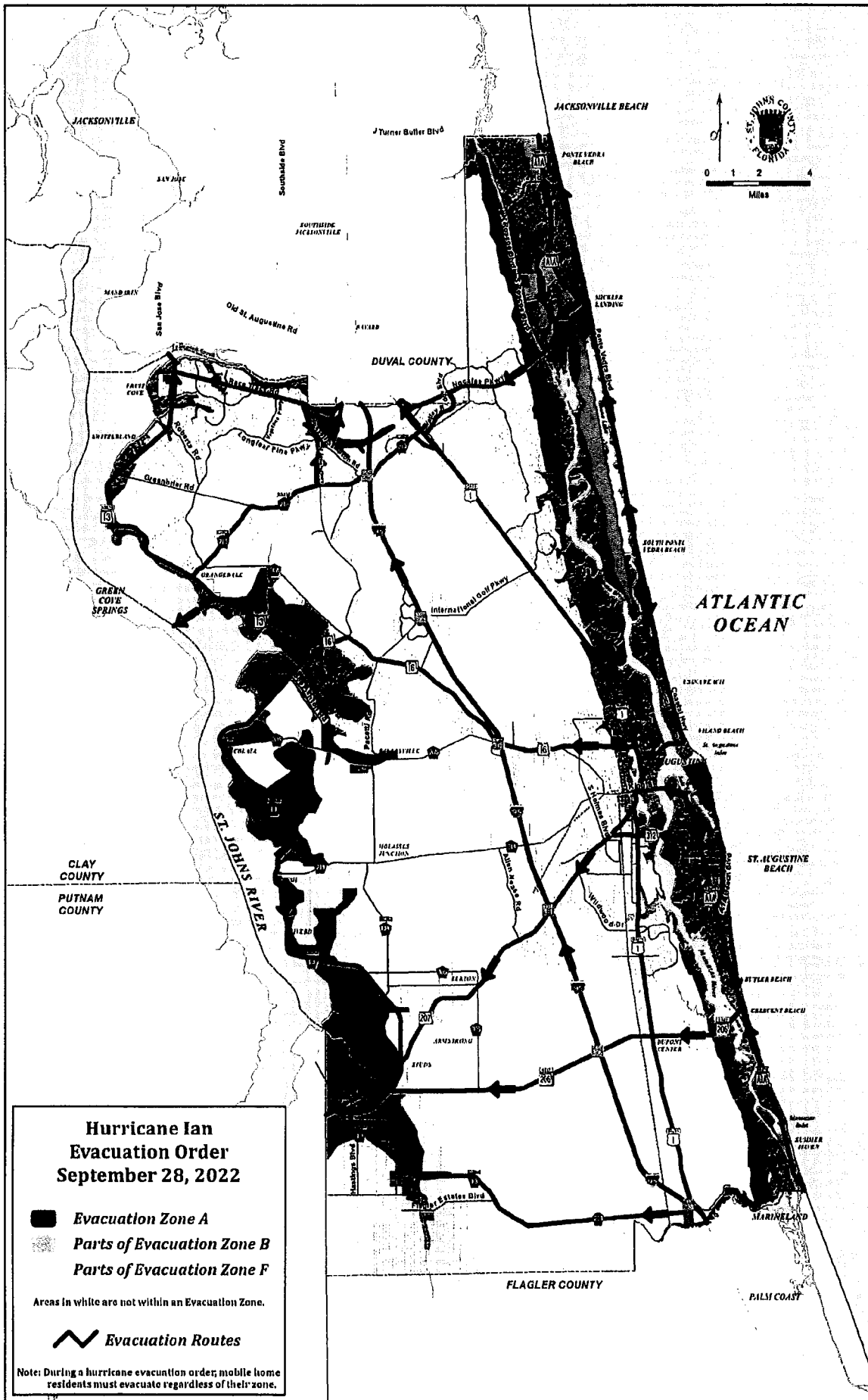

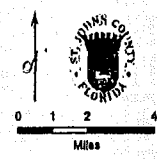
