ST. JOHNS COUNTY EMERGENCY ORDER 2024-3

AN ORDER EXTENDING THE LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY ORDER AS PROVIDED BY PART I, CHAPTER 252, FLORIDA STATUTES AND BY ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA ORDINANCE NO. 2021-4

WHEREAS, a state of local emergency was declared and enacted through St. Johns County Emergency Order 2024-2, as authorized by Chapter 252, Florida Statutes and St. Johns County Ordinance No. 2021-4, because of the threat of a potential public health and safety crisis resulting from FCC Environmental's failure to collect all household trash, recycling and yard waste within the County in a timely manner; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County is exerting efforts to address emergency conditions and assist affected citizens; and

WHEREAS, further extending the declared and enacted state of local emergency facilitates St. Johns County's ability to continue to effectively respond to and mitigate any further issues resulting from solid waste not being collected.

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the emergency power vested in the County pursuant to Chapter 252, Florida Statutes, and St. Johns County Ordinance No. 2021-4, it is hereby ordered that:

- The state of local emergency declared and enacted through St. Johns County 1. Emergency Order 2024-2 is hereby extended for seven (7) days from the effective date of this Order, unless earlier rescinded by the Board.
- All emergency powers authorized by St. Johns County Emergency Order 2024-2 are hereby retained, ratified, and continued in time for the duration of the state of local emergency.
