

ORDINANCE NUMBER 72-6

INTRODUCED BY COMMISSIONER H. F. (FRED) GREEN

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, TO APPROPRIATE IN ITS DISCRETION, FROM SUCH FUNDS AS MAY BE AVAILABLE, NOT EXCEEDING \$2,500.00 YEARLY, TO BE USED BY SAID BOARD OR PAID DIRECTLY TO AN INDEPENDENT AGENCY, FOR THE SHELTERING AND CARE OF STRAY ANIMALS IN AN EFFORT TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF RABIES OR OTHER CONTAGIOUS DISEASES, AND PROVIDING TIME FOR TAKING EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, be, and it is hereby empowered to appropriate in its discretion, from such funds as may be available, not exceeding \$2,500.00 yearly, to be used by said Board or paid directly to an independent agency, for the sheltering and care of stray animals in an effort to prevent the spread of rabies or other contagious diseases.

Section 2. Chapter 65-2167, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1965, and all ordinances and laws or parts of laws in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment by the Office of the Secretary of State, to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners, that same has been filed.

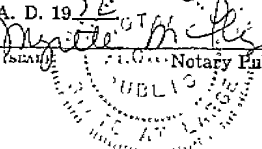
