

ORDINANCE NUMBER 74- 6

INTRODUCED BY COMMISSIONER GREEN

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, CREATING A SPECIAL PURPOSE TAX DISTRICT TO INCLUDE ALL OF THE UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, ENTITLED "ST. JOHNS COUNTY FIRE PREVENTION AND CONTROL DISTRICT" AND AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SAID COUNTY TO LEVY A MILLAGE NOT EXCEEDING ONE-HALF MILL PER DOLLAR OF VALUE ASSESSED ON ALL PROPERTY IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY FIRE PREVENTION AND CONTROL DISTRICT; SUCH FUNDS TO BE USED EXCLUSIVELY IN SAID UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY FOR FIRE PREVENTION AND CONTROL AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. There is hereby created a special purpose tax district comprising all of the unincorporated areas of St. Johns County, Florida, to be known as "St. Johns County Fire Prevention and Control District".

Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, is hereby authorized and empowered to levy a millage not exceeding one-half mill per dollar of value assessed on all property in said county lying within said District and lying outside the limits of any incorporated town or municipality to be used exclusively in said St. Johns County Fire Prevention and Control District for fire prevention and control.

Section 3. All such sums collected by said millage shall be administered by the Board of County Commissioners and kept separate and apart from all other funds, and used only for such purposes.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment by the office of the Secretary of State to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners, that same has been filed.

JOHNS COUNTY COURTHOUSE, ST. AUGUSTINE, FLORIDA, WILL CONSIDER THE PASSAGE OF THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE: AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST.
