

ORDINANCE NUMBER 77-20

INTRODUCED BY COMMISSIONER BENET

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, REPEALING THAT PORTION OF SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE 77-19 WHICH PROVIDED THAT THE CRESCENT BEACH RAMP IN THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS WAS DESIGNATED AS ONE-WAY EXIT FROM THE BEACH GOING WESTERLY ONLY FROM APRIL 15TH TO SEPTEMBER 15TH OF EACH YEAR; AND PROVIDING FOR ORDINANCE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by unanimous vote of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that an emergency exists with reference to traffic problems in the vicinity of Crescent Beach, and that Ordinance 77-19 in Section 3 designating Crescent Beach ramp as a one-way exit from the beach going westerly only from April 15th to September 15th of each year would increase traffic problems, and that it is necessary for the public welfare, safety and convenience that an emergency ordinance be passed repealing said portion of Ordinance 77-19.

NOW, THEREFORE, this Commission determines that an emergency exists and that immediate enactment of this ordinance is necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That this Board determines that an emergency exists and waives notice of requirements and determines that the immediate enactment of this ordinance is necessary.

Section 2. That that portion of Section 3 of Ordinance 77-19 which reads as follows:

"That the Crescent Beach ramp in the County of St. Johns is hereby designated as one-way exit from the beach going westerly only, from April 15th to September 15th of each year."  
be, and the same is hereby, repealed.

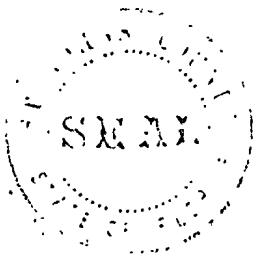

This is an emergency ordinance enacted under Section 125.66, Florida Statutes, Subparagraph 3, and shall take effect when a copy has been accepted by the postal authorities of the government of the United States for special delivery by registered mail to the Department of State of the State of Florida.
