

ORDINANCE NUMBER 78 - 32

INTRODUCED BY: COMMISSIONER BENET

AN ORDINANCE OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA REPEALING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCES NUMBERED 77-19, 77-20 AND 77-23, WHICH REGULATED THE TRAFFIC PATTERN AND FLOW OF TRAFFIC ON THE BEACHES BORDERING THE ATLANTIC OCEAN FROM 4TH STREET IN THE TOWN OF ST. AUGUSTINE BEACH, FLORIDA, SOUTH TO CRESCENT BEACH RAMP IN ST. JOHNS COUNTY; AND WHICH ALSO REGULATED TRAFFIC FLOW ON THE 4TH STREET RAMP, THE "A" STREET RAMP; AND THE CRESCENT BEACH RAMP; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1: St. Johns County, Florida Ordinances numbered 77-19, 77-20 and 77-23 which regulated the traffic pattern and flow of traffic on the beaches bordering the Atlantic Ocean from 4th Street in the town of St. Augustine Beach, Florida, south to Crescent Beach ramp in St. Johns County; and which also regulated traffic flow on the 4th Street ramp, the "A" Street ramp; and the Crescent Beach ramp are repealed.

Section 2: This ordinance shall take effect at 1:00 o'clock a.m. on Wednesday, May 17, 1978.
