

ORDINANCE NUMBER: 78-54

INTRODUCED BY: COMMISSIONER BENET

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, AMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 72-7, WHICH IS THE ORDINANCE THAT LEVIED SEPTIC TANK PERMIT FEES AND ELECTRICAL PERMIT FEES IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF THIS COUNTY: THIS AMENDMENT INCREASES THE FEE FOR A SEPTIC TANK PERMIT FROM \$5.00 to \$25.00 AND PROVIDES AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA.

Section 1. St. Johns County Ordinance No. 72-7, which is the ordinance levying septic tank permits fees and electrical permit fees in the unincorporated areas of St. Johns County, is hereby amended by deleting the existing Section 1 therefrom.

Section 2. The following is hereby added to St. Johns County Ordinance No. 72-7.

"Section 1. St. Johns County, Florida hereby levies a \$25.00 charge for each septic tank permit issued through the office of the St. Johns County Building Inspector."

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment by the Office of the Secretary of State to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that same has been filed.
