AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, AMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 76-20, WHICH IS THE ORDINANCE DEFINING, CLARIFYING AND REGULATING CONTRACTORS AND THE BUSINESS OF CONTRACTING: TRADES EXAMINING BOARD DESIGNATING ITS MEMBERS AND PRESCRIBING ITS POWERS, DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: PRESCRIBING QUALIFICATIONS, AND PROVIDING FOR THE REGISTRATION, EXAMINATION AND CERTIFICATION OF CONTRACTORS, THE RENEWAL THEREOF AND MAKING CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS AND EXEMPTIONS: PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT AND COLLECTION OF FEES IN CONNECTION THEREOF: MAKING CERTAIN ACTS UNLAWFUL AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE: THIS AMENDMENT PROVIDES THAT THE INSTALLATION OF DUCTS OR DUCT SYSTEMS ONLY MAY BE PERFORMED BY NON-LICENSED MECHANICS UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A MASTER HEATER, AIR-CONDITIONER OR REFRIGERATOR CONTRACTOR AND ALSO PROVIDES THAT EACH DAY THAT ANY VIOLATION OF THE ORIGINAL ORDINANCE, AS AMENDED, SHALL CONTINUE CONSTITUTE A SEPARATE OFFENSE, AND PROVIDES AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. St. Johns County Ordinance No. 76-20, which is the ordinance pertaining to contractors and the regulation of contractors is hereby amended as follows:

(i) Paragraphs G and H of Section 1, Definitions, are deleted and the following paragraphs are added and substituted in their stead:

G. The term "Journeyman Heating, Air Conditioning, Refrigeration Contractor" as used in this Ordinance shall be held to mean any person who possesses the necessary qualifications, training and technical knowledge to install, maintain, repair, fabricate, alter, extend or design, when not prohibited by law, central air conditioning, refrigeration, heating and ventilating, including duct work in connection with a complete system only to the extent such duct work is performed by the contractor necessary to make complete an air distribution system, boiler and unfired pressure vessel systems, and all appurtenances, apparatus, or equipment used in connection therewith; also piping, insulation of pipes, vessels and ducts, pressure and process piping, pneumatic control piping, and installation of a condensate drain from an approved disposal other than a direct connection to a sanitary system. All such work shall be under the supervision of a Master Heating, Air Conditioning, Refrigeration Contractor. The installation of ducts or duct systems only may be performed by non-licensed mechanics under the supervision of a master heater, air conditioner or refrigeration contractor.

H. The term "Sheet Metal Contractor" as used in this ordinance shall be held to mean any person whose services are unlimited in the sheet metal trade and who has the experience, knowledge and skill

necessary for the manufacture, fabrication, assembling, handling, erection, installation, dismantling, conditioning, adjustment, alteration, repair, servicing, and design, when not prohibited by law, of ferrous, or non-ferrous metal work of U.S. No. 1 guage or its equivalent or lighter guage and other materials used in lieu thereof.

- (ii) Section VI, Certification, is amended by deleting the requirement that the fee for a Certificate of Competency or certificate issued under this ordinance be \$5.00 for Journeyman Electrician, Journeyman Plumber, Journeyman Air-Conditioning, Journeyman Heating, Air Conditioning, Refrigeration, and Journeyman Sheet Metal Mechanic; and by requiring instead that the fee for such certificate be \$5.00 for Journeyman Electrician, Journeyman Plumber, Journeyman Air Conditioning and Journeyman Heating, Air Conditioning, Refrigeration Mechanic.
- (iii) Section XI, Penalty, is deleted and the following section is added and substituted in its stead:

SECTION XI. Penalty

Persons violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished as described in ST. JOHNS COUNTY CONTRACTORS REVIEW BOARD and/or shall be prosecuted by the Prosecutor of St. Johns County, and upon conviction in a court having jurisdiction of misdemeanors, shall be punished by a fine, not to exceed \$500.00 or by imprisonment in the County Jail, not to exceed ninety (90) days, or by any combination of the foregoing. Each day that any violation shall continue shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment by the Office of the Secretary of State to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that same has been filed.
