AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, AMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 72-7, WHICH IS THE ORDINANCE LEVYING SEPTIC TANK PERMIT FEES AND ELECTRICAL PERMIT FEES IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF SAID COUNTY; THIS AMENDMENT DEFINES THE PENALTIES AND PROVIDES THAT EACH DAY AN OFFENSE OR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE, AS AMENDED, CONTINUES SHALL BE DEEMED A SEPARATE OFFENSE; AND PROVIDES AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. St. Johns County Ordinance No. 72-7, which is the ordinance described in the above title, is hereby amended as follows:

THE PENALTY PROVISION (SECTION 5) IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

Section 5. Any person, firm or corporation found guilty of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor which, upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$500.00 or by imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed 60 days or both such fine and imprisonment. Each day that an offense or violation of this ordinance, as amended, continues shall be deemed a separate offense.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment by the Office of the Secretary of State to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that same has been filed.
