

ORDINANCE NUMBER: 78-78

INTRODUCED BY: COMMISSIONER BENET

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, AMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 76-12, WHICH IS THE ORDINANCE REGULATING OUTDOOR MUSICAL ENTERTAINMENT, FESTIVALS, DEFINING SAME AND REQUIRING PERMIT AND BOND. THIS AMENDMENT DEFINES THE PENALTIES AND PROVIDES THAT EACH DAY AN OFFENSE OR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE, AS AMENDED, CONTINUES SHALL BE DEEMED A SEPARATE OFFENSE; AND PROVIDES AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDIANED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. St. Johns County Ordinance No. 76-12, which is the ordinance described in the above title, is hereby amended as follows:

The penalty provision (Section 8d) is amended to read as follows:

SECTION 8(d) Any person, firm or corporation found guilty of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor which, upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$500.00 or by imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed 60 days, or both such fine and imprisonment. Each day that an offense or violation of this ordinance, as amended, continues shall be deemed a separate offense.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment by the Office of the Secretary of State to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that same has been filed.
