

ORDINANCE NUMBER: 80-25

INTRODUCED BY: COMMISSIONER CURTAN

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, AMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 76-20, AND ST. JOHNS COUNTY CODE CHAPTER 6, ARTICLE V, WHICH PROVIDES FOR THE REGISTRATION, EXAMINATION, AND CERTIFICATION OF CONTRACTORS, AND PAYMENT AND COLLECTION OF FEES THEREOF. THIS AMENDMENT PROVIDES FOR ADJUSTMENT OF FEES FOR EXAMINATION FOR CERTIFICATION AND PROVIDES AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. Paragraph (F) of Section VI, St. Johns County

Ordinance 76-20 is hereby deleted and the following substituted in its stead:

F. Application for examinations as herein provided shall be made to the Building Inspector in writing on forms furnished by the Building Department, shall be accompanied by an application fee of \$100.00 for General Contractor, Class "A", Building Contractor, Class "B", Residential Contractor, Class "C"; \$100.00 for Masters Certificates Examinations; and \$50.00 for Journeyman Certificate Examinations; \$50.00 for all other examinations.

Applicants for Journeyman Electrician, Journeyman Plumbers, and Journeyman Heating and Airconditioning, Refrigeration shall submit satisfactory evidence that they have had a minimum of two years experience or education in the field for which certification is being sought. Two years experience shall be experience gained through working as an apprentice or helper in the appropriate trade for two years; or one year of education in a recognized accredited college or vocational school plus one year of manual experience in the applicable electrical, plumbing, mechanical, heating, airconditioning or refrigeration construction trade,

SECTION 2. Paragraph (d), Section 6-76, Article V, Chapter 6

of St. Johns County Code is hereby deleted and the following substituted in its stead:

(d) Applications for examination generally; fee; filing date. Applications for examinations as herein provided shall be made to the building inspector, in writing, on forms furnished by the building department and shall be accompanied by an application fee as follows:

General contractor, Class A; building contractor, Class B; residential contractor, Class C, certificate examination .....\$100.00

Master Certificate examinations.....\$100.00

Journeyman Certificate examinations.....\$ 50.00

All applications for any examination must be filed with the building inspector not less than three (3) weeks prior to the date of the examination.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon receipt of official acknowledgement by the Office of the Secretary of State to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that same has been filed.

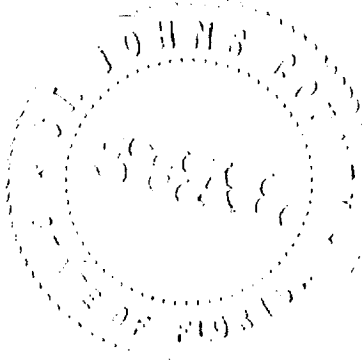
