

ORDINANCE NUMBER: 81-56

INTRODUCED BY: COMMISSIONER CURTAN

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING A MUNICIPAL SERVICE TAXING UNIT KNOWN AS THE ST. AUGUSTINE SOUTH LIGHTING DISTRICT, ESTABLISHING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE DISTRICT; AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY TO LEVY A MILLAGE NOT EXCEEDING ONE-HALF MILL PER DOLLAR OF VALUE ASSESSED ON ALL PROPERTY IN THE DISTRICT; SUCH FUNDS TO BE USED EXCLUSIVELY IN THE DISTRICT FOR STREET LIGHTING; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. There is hereby created and established a Municipal Service Taxing Unit to be known as the St. Augustine South Lighting District, hereinafter referred to as District.

Section 2. The District shall consist of all lands in St. Johns County, Florida, that are within the boundaries created by the hereinafter described roads and shall also include all residential lots that are located adjacent to said roads even though they are without or outside the boundary formed by the roads:

That portion of St. Augustine South bounded on the North by Shore Drive; on the East by Shore Drive; on the South by Shore Drive; on the West by Shore Drive from the South boundary to Azalea Road, then by Azalea Road to Segovia Road, then by Segovia Road to St. Augustine South Drive; then by St. Augustine South Drive to Cornell Road; and then by Cornell Road, in a Northerly direction to Shore Drive, and the point of beginning.

Section 3. The Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, shall be the governing body of the District.

Section 4. The Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, is hereby authorized and empowered to levy a millage not exceeding one-half mill per dollar of value assessed on all real property in said District to be used exclusively in said District for street lighting.

Section 5. All such sums collected by said millage shall be administered by the Board of County Commissioners and kept separate and apart from all other funds, and used only for street lighting purposes.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment by the Office of the Secretary of State to the Clerk

of the Board of County Commissioners, that same has been filed.

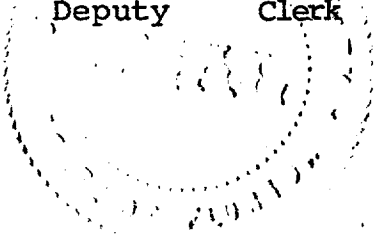
