

ORDINANCE NUMBER: 81-59

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, AMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE #76-20, AS AMENDED, WHICH IS THE ORDINANCE DEFINING, CLARIFYING AND REGULATING CONTRACTORS AND THE BUSINESS OF CONTRACTING: TRADES EXAMINING BOARD DESIGNATING ITS MEMBERS AND PRESCRIBING ITS POWERS, DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: PRESCRIBING QUALIFICATIONS, AND PROVIDING FOR THE REGISTRATION, EXAMINATION AND CERTIFICATION OF CONTRACTORS, THE RENEWAL THEREOF AND MAKING CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS AND EXEMPTIONS: PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT AND COLLECTION OF FEES IN CONNECTION THEREOF AND MAKING CERTAIN ACTS UNLAWFUL. THIS AMENDMENT CHANGES THE REQUIRED SURETY PENAL BOND FROM \$1,000.00 TO \$3,000.00; AND PROVIDES AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The first paragraph of subsection B of Section IV of St. Johns County Ordinance #76-20 is deleted and the following first paragraph is substituted in its stead:

BOND

A good and sufficient bond in the penal sum of three thousand dollars payable to St. Johns County, Florida, with applicants as principle, and with surety companies authorized to do business in this State as surety thereon shall be filed with the St. Johns County Building Department, further conditioned that the principal shall well and surely comply with the provisions of all St. Johns County Ordinances. Should any bond so required for any reason become insufficient, the Chief Building Inspector may require a new bond be filed forthwith; and upon failure to do so the certificate issued to such principal shall be immediately and automatically suspended and it shall be unlawful thereafter for such principal to engage in such business until such certificate is reinstated as provided below.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment by the Office of the Secretary of State to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that same has been filed.
