AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, AMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE #78-1, ENTITLED ST. JOHNS COUNTY/ST. AUGUSTINE AIRPORT ZONING ORDINANCE; THIS AMENDMENT FURTHER RESTRICTS THE HEIGHT OF STRUCTURES BY INCLUDING A MINIMUM VECTORING ALTITUDE; PROVIDES A DEFINITION AND PROVIDES AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. St. Johns County Ordinance #78-1 known as the St. Johns County/ St. Augustine Airport Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:

a.) Paragraph F. Other Zones, in Section III is deleted and the following is added and substituted in its stead:

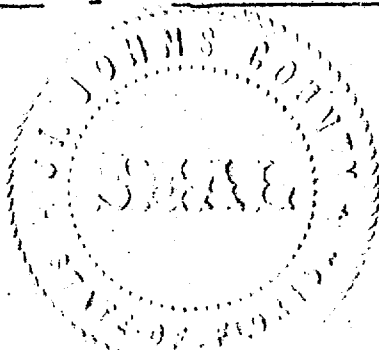
F. Other Zones - In addition to the height limitations imposed in paragraphs A through E of this section, no structure or obstruction will be permitted that exceeds 500 feet above airport elevation within 10 nautical miles of St. Augustine Municipal Airport, and no structure or obstruction will be permitted within St. Johns County that would cause a minimum obstruction clearance altitude, a minimum descent altitude, decision height, or a minimum vectoring altitude to be raised.

b.) The following paragraph is added to Section II - Definitions.

(10.5) "MINIMUM VECTORING ALTITUDE - The lowest MSL altitude at which an IFR aircraft will be vectored by a radar controller, except when otherwise authorized for radar approaches, departures and missed approaches."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment by the Office of the Secretary of State to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that same has been filed.
