AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCES 73-1, 73-4, 73-5, 74-3 AND 77-7, WHICH ARE THE ORDINANCES ESTABLISHING AND ENACTING A COMPREHENSIVE ZONING CODE FOR ZONING DISTRICTS A, B, C, D AND E, BEING ALL THE UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, EXCEPTING THEREFROM THE PONTE VEDRA ZONING DISTRICT, STATE AND NATIONAL PARKS, AND ALL INCORPORATED CITIES AND TOWNS. THIS AMENDMENT REQUIRES EXCEPTIONS FOR INCREASE IN MAXIMUM HEIGHT TO BE APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND FURTHER PROVIDES AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, ST. JOHNS COUNTY,

FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. Subsection A, of Section 11-9-1 of the St. Johns County Ordinances numbers 73-1, 73-4, 73-5, 74-3 and 77-6. Zoning Exceptions, is hereby deleted and the following is substituted in its stead:

11-9-1. Zoning Exceptions

- a. <u>In General</u>. In the granting of zoning exceptions the Zoning Board may provide such conditions and safeguards as may be appropriate and in harmony with the purpose and intent of the Zoning Code.
 - (1). All exceptions for increase in permitted height of structure may be granted by the Board of County Commissioners. Such requests shall be Considered by the Zoning Board and Board of County Commissioners pursuant to requirements of Sections 11-11, requiring Public Hearing and Notification. The Zoning Board shall submit a report and recommendation pursuant to Section 11-10-4.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon receipt of official acknowledgment by the Office of the Secretary of State to The Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that same has been filed.
