

ORDINANCE NUMBER: 82- 41

INTRODUCED BY: COMMISSIONER WALDRON

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF TAX REVENUES OF THE PONTE VEDRA BEACH MUNICIPAL SERVICE TAXING UNIT CREATED BY ORDINANCE #81-84 TO THE MUNICIPAL SERVICE DISTRICT OF PONTE VEDRA BEACH CREATED BY SENATE BILL #15D, FLORIDA LEGISLATURE, 1982; DISSOLVING THE PONTE VEDRA BEACH MUNICIPAL SERVICE TAXING UNIT, AND TRANSFERRING ITS RIGHTS AND DUTIES TO THE MUNICIPAL SERVICE DISTRICT OF PONTE VEDRA BEACH; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. All tax revenues assessed, levied and received or to be received by the Ponte Vedra Beach Municipal Service Taxing Unit created pursuant to St. Johns County Ordinance #81-84 are hereby ordered to be transferred to the Municipal Service District of Ponte Vedra Beach as created by Senate Bill #15D, Florida Legislature, 1982.

Section 2. The Clerk of Courts of St. Johns County, Florida, and the Tax Collector of St. Johns County, Florida, are hereby authorized and directed to assist in the transfer of tax revenues described in Section 1. above.

Section 3. The Municipal Service District of Ponte Vedra Beach is hereby authorized to collect the tax revenues described in Section 1. above and to institute legal proceedings for such purposes in the name of, and on behalf of, the Ponte Vedra Beach Municipal Service Taxing Unit, whether or not said Taxing Unit created by Ordinance #81-84 is in existence or has been dissolved.

Section 4. Effective July 20, 1982, the Ponte Vedra Beach Municipal Service Taxing Unit created by Ordinance #81-84 is dissolved and terminated and the Municipal Service District of Ponte Vedra Beach created by Senate Bill #15D, Florida Legislature, shall assume its rights and duties.

Section 5. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment by the Office of the Secretary of State to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners, that same has been filed.
