

ORDINANCE NUMBER: 83-4

INTRODUCED BY: COMMISSIONER WALDRON

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, AMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 80-17 WHICH IS THE BEACH/RAMP FEE ORDINANCE: THIS AMENDMENT RAISES THE PRICE OF THE YEARLY SEASONAL FEE FROM \$7.50 TO \$10.00; AND PROVIDES AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. St. Johns County Ordinance No. 80-17, which is the ordinance described in the above title, is hereby amended as follows:

Section 2 is deleted and the following is added and substituted in its stead:

Section 2. There is hereby levied a \$1.00 fee per day per motor vehicle or a \$10.00 yearly seasonal fee per motor vehicle for the use of all County controlled or County owned or maintained beach access ramps used for ingress to the County beaches and/or the Atlantic Ocean public beaches within the corporate limits of the City of St. Augustine Beach.

Section 3 is deleted and the following is added and substituted in its stead:

Section 3. There is hereby levied a \$1.00 fee per day per motor vehicle or a \$10.00 yearly seasonal fee per motor vehicle for driving or parking a motor vehicle on County beaches when entry to the beach is by other than County controlled or County owned or maintained access ramps.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgement by the Office of the Secretary of State to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that same has been filed.
