

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, AMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 72-2 AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED, WHICH IS THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE TAX ORDINANCE, THIS AMENDMENT CHANGES THE YEARLY RATE THAT WILL BE CHARGED TO WATER COMPANIES AND SEWER COMPANIES: AND IT PROVIDES AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. St. Johns County Ordinance No. 72-2, as previously amended, which is the ordinance described in the above title, is hereby amended by deleting:

Sec. 205.561 WATER COMPANIES AND SEWAGE DISPOSAL COMPANIES	
Based on city population	
999 or less	\$15.00
10,000 - 19,999	\$112.50

and by adding and substituting the following in its stead:

Sec. 205.561 WATER COMPANIES AND SEWAGE DISPOSAL COMPANIES	
Based on number of customers served	
9,999 or less	\$15.00
10,000 - 19,999	\$112.50
20,000 or more	\$250.00

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment by the Office of the Secretary of State to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that the same has been filed.
