

ORDINANCE 85-20

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A DEFERRED COMPENSATION PLAN FOR THE PURPOSE OF ALLOWING EMPLOYEES OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PLAN AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the County of St. Johns desires to establish a deferred compensation plan for its employees as authorized in Section 457 of the Internal Revenue Code and §112.215, Florida Statute, and

WHEREAS, the County benefits from the establishment of said plan by being able to offer its employees the opportunity to build supplemental retirement income and thereby enabling the County to attract and retain competent personnel.

NOW, WHEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS.

Section 1. The County of St. Johns hereby authorizes a Deferred Compensation Plan.

Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners of the County of St. Johns approves the recommendation of the County Finance Director.

Section 3. The Finance Director after review by the County Attorney is hereby authorized to execute the necessary documents setting forth the relationship between the County and the vendors, who will be approved by subsequent resolution(s).

Section 4. The Finance Director is hereby authorized to execute the required joinder agreement with each employee who desires to participate in the plans.

Section 5. Additional companies may be authorized to be added to the County Deferred Compensation Plan by Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgement from the Office of the Secretary of State to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners that same has been filed.
