

ORDINANCE NUMBER: 85-43

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA ASSESSING IN CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER COSTS, AN ADDITIONAL \$2.00 TO BE USED FOR APPROVED CRIMINAL JUSTICE EDUCATION AND TRAINING; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. There is hereby assessed by St. Johns County in compliance with section 943.25(8), F.S., an additional two and No/100 (\$2.00) dollars, as court costs against every person convicted for violation of a state penal or criminal statute or convicted of a municipal or county ordinance, where said offense occurred within St. Johns County. In addition, two and No/100 (\$2.00) dollars shall be deducted from every bond estreature or forfeited bail bond related to such penal statutes or ordinances. However, no such assessment shall be made against any person convicted for violation of any state statute, municipal or county ordinance relating to the parking of vehicles.

All such assessments shall be collected by the appropriate court and shall be remitted to St. Johns County and used only for criminal justice education degree programs and training courses for members of the Sheriff's department; provided that such education degree programs and training courses are first approved by the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission.

Section 2. All County ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith are to the extent of the conflict superceded hereby.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment by the Office of the Secretary of State to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that same has been filed.
