

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, DECLARING THAT AN EMERGENCY EXISTS AND PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT BY THE COUNTY OF PARKING TICKETS RECEIVED BY JURORS UPON THE CLERK'S DETERMINATION THAT CERTAIN CRITERIA HAVE BEEN MET; PROVIDING CRITERIA FOR PAYMENT OF JUROR PARKING TICKETS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, hereby determines that a public purpose is served by having the County pay parking tickets received by jurors during their jury service provided such jurors have complied with the criteria set forth below; and,

WHEREAS, local newspapers have reported that the County will pay certain juror parking tickets and the Board is advised by its Clerk that the jurors are relying on such reports.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. In order to prevent any confusion as to the ability of the County to pay parking tickets received by jurors who have complied with the criteria set forth below, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, waives notice requirements for this emergency Ordinance and declares that an emergency exists and that the immediate enactment of this emergency ordinance is necessary.

Section 2. The Clerk of the Circuit Court is authorized to pay to the City of St. Augustine within thirty (30) days of issuance of those parking citations received by jurors who have followed the criteria set forth below such sums as are set out on the citations from the proper account of St. Johns County.

Section 3. In order for the County to pay a juror's parking citation, the juror must have first complied with the following criteria:

a) Jurors summoned for jury service by proper form to serve as a juror in the Court of St. Johns County, State of Florida should note the parking areas on said summons.

b) Jurors so summoned should note the telephone number on the jury summons and call this number as instructed on jury summons.

c) Should a juror properly summoned find the parking areas designated on jury summons filled, the juror should secure parking in an undesignated parking area. Jurors parking in an undesignated metered parking area should pay the parking meter to its full allowable time. Should jury serving be such that time does not allow further proper payment to the undesignated parking meter and a parking citation is issued to the juror, the juror should turn such parking citation over to the Clerk of the Circuit Court or his designated deputy clerk.

Section 4. The Clerk of the Circuit Court of St. Johns County is hereby directed to report quarterly to the Board of County Commissioners the total number of parking citations and the total amounts paid from County funds.

Section 5. This Ordinance is passed pursuant to Florida Statute 125.66(3) and shall take effect when a copy has been accepted by the postal authorities of the United States for special delivery by registered mail to the Department of State.

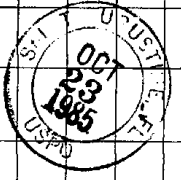
