

ORDINANCE NUMBER : 86-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, AMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 84-61 WHICH IS THE ORDINANCE REQUIRING DOGS TO BE ON LEASHES IN CERTAIN SUBDIVISIONS WITHIN THE COUNTY; THIS AMENDMENT ADDS SUNSET PARK SUBDIVISION, AS RECORDED IN MAP BOOK 8 PAGE 72 OF THE OFFICIAL PUBLIC RECORDS OF THE COUNTY AS A SUBDIVISION IN WHICH DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASHES; IT PROVIDES PENALTIES; AND PROVIDES AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. St. Johns County Ordinance No. 84-61, which is the ordinance described in the above title, is hereby amended by adding the following subdivision to the list of subdivisions contained in Section One of the ordinance.

Sunset Park Subdivision as recorded in Map Book 8 Page 72 of the official public records of St. Johns County, Florida.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment by the Office of the Secretary of State to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that same has been filed.

JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AT ITS REGULAR MEETING ON JANUARY 7, 1986 AT 10:15 O'CLOCK A.M., IN THE COUNTY AUDITORIUM, COUNTY ADMINISTRATION BUILDING, LEWIS SPEEDWAY (COUNTY ROAD 16-A) AND U.S. #1 NORTH, ST. AUGUSTINE, FLORIDA, WILL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER THE PASSAGE OF THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE:

An ordinance of the County of St. Johns, State of Florida, amending St. Johns County Ordinance 84-61 which is the ordinance requiring dogs to be on leashes in certain subdivisions within the county; This Amendment adds Sunset Park Subdivision, as recorded in Map Book 8 Page 72 of the official public records of the County as a subdivision in which dogs must be kept on leashes; it provides penalties; and provides an effective date.

All parties having any interest in said Ordinance will be afforded an opportunity to be heard at the public hearing.

If a person decides to appeal any decision made by the Board of County Commissioners with respect to any matter considered at the meeting or hearing, he will need a record of the proceedings, and for such purpose he may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
