

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, AMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 84-61 WHICH IS THE ORDINANCE REQUIRING DOGS TO BE ON LEASHES IN CERTAIN SUBDIVISIONS WITHIN THE COUNTY; THIS AMENDMENT ADDS:

SANDY HEIGHTS SUBDIVISION AS RECORDED IN MAP BOOK 12, PAGES 50 AND 51, OFFICIAL PUBLIC RECORDS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY.

CENTURY HILLS SUBDIVISION AS RECORDED IN MAP BOOK 12, PAGES 48 AND 49, OFFICIAL PUBLIC RECORDS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY,

SOUTHWEST WOODS SUBDIVISION AS RECORDED IN MAP BOOK 13, PAGES 106 AND 107, OFFICIAL PUBLIC RECORDS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, AND

LYNDALE ACRES SUBDIVISION AS RECORDED IN MAP BOOK 14, PAGES 90 AND 91, OFFICIAL PUBLIC RECORDS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY,

AS SUBDIVISIONS IN WHICH DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASHES; IT PROVIDES PENALTIES; AND PROVIDES AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. St. Johns County Ordinance No. 84-61, which is the ordinance described in the above title, is hereby amended by adding the following subdivisions to the list of subdivisions contained in Section One of the ordinance.

Sandy Heights Subdivision as recorded in Map Book 12, pages 50 and 51, official public records of St. Johns County.

Century Hills Subdivision as recorded in Map Book 12, pages 48 and 49, official public records of St. Johns County.

Southwest Woods Subdivision as recorded in Map Book 13, pages 106 and 107, official public records of St. Johns County, and

Lyndale Acres Subdivision as recorded in Map Book 14, pages 90 and 91, official public records of St. Johns County.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment by the Office of the Secretary of State to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that same has been filed.

AUGUSTINE, FLORIDA, WILL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER THE PASSAGE OF THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE:

As subdivisions in which dogs must be kept on leashes; it provides penalties; and provides an effective date.
The proposed Ordinance is on file in the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court, St. Johns County, Florida, St. Johns County Administration Building, Lewis Speedway, and may be examined by parties interested prior to said public hearing. All parties having any interest in said Ordinance will be afforded an opportunity to be heard at the public hearing.
If a person decides to appeal any decision made by the Board of County Commissioners with respect to any matter considered at the meeting or hearing, he will need a record of the proceedings, and for such purpose he may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
