

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO FAIL TO TIMELY RETURN ANY BOOK OR MATERIAL OF THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY PUBLIC LIBRARY; PROVIDING PENALTIES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to i) keep, ii) retain, iii) fail to return or in lieu of returning, fail to pay the St. Johns County Public Library its cost to replace plus \$2.00 processing costs, or iv) have in their possession any book, newspaper, magazine, pamphlet, manuscript, article or other property of the St. Johns County Public Library or any of its branches, after thirty (30) days written notice has been mailed by certified mail addressed to such person as their address is listed in the current records of the St. Johns County Library system, wherein such notice advises such person to return such property to the St. Johns County Public Library or, if appropriate, to a branch library, or to pay the library's replacement cost of such property plus \$2.00 processing costs. No such notice will be effective if mailed prior to the time which by the rules of the St. Johns County Library system, such book newspaper, magazine, pamphlet, manuscript, article or property of the St. Johns County Library must be returned.

Section 2. PENALTIES: Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall be prosecuted in the same manner as misdemeanors are prosecuted and shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$50.00 per any book, newspaper, magazine, pamphlet, manuscript, article or other property of the St. Johns County Public Library system unlawfully kept, retained, possessed or not returned or paid for by such person, firm or corporation, or by imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed thirty (30) days, or by both such fines and imprisonment. Each day that an offense or violation of this ordinance continues, shall be deemed a separate offense.

Section 3. SEVERABILITY. Should any line, phrase, word, section or provisions of this ordinance, or the application of any provision of this ordinance be declared by the courts to be unconstitutional or invalid, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment by the Office of the Secretary of State, to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners that same has been filed.
