

ORDINANCE NUMBER 87-41

AN ORDINANCE OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, STATE OF FLORIDA ESTABLISHING AND REQUIRING PAYMENT OF A FIXED FEE RATE FOR DISPOSAL OF TIRES AT THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY LANDFILL; PROHIBITING THE DISPOSAL OF TIRES ELSEWHERE IN THE COUNTY; PROVIDING PENALTIES AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. No person or entity shall dump, abandon, or discard any tire within the unincorporated area of St. Johns County other than at the St. Johns County Tillman Ridge Landfill or the County owned solid waste transfer stations as allowed by Section 2 of this ordinance.

Section 2. No person or entity shall dump, abandon, or discard any tire at the St. Johns County Landfill located at Tillman Ridge or at the County owned solid waste transfer stations until and unless they shall have first paid to St. Johns County the following fees for each such tire dumped, abandoned, or discarded at said landfill or County transfer station:

- i) \$0.50 per tire for up to and including 10 tires per delivery
- ii) More than 10 tires delivered at the same time shall be disposed of only at the County landfill located at Tillman Ridge:
\$45.00 per ton - (If tires are split: \$26.00 per ton)

Section 3. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall be prosecuted in the same manner as misdemeanors are prosecuted and shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine not to exceed \$500.00 or by imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed sixty (60) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Each tire dumped, abandoned, or discarded in violation of this ordinance, shall be deemed a separate offense.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgement by the Office of the Secretary of State, to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners that same has been filed.
