AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, REZONING LANDS AS DESCRIBED HEREINAFTER FROM PRESENT ZONING CLASSIFICATION OF RG1
TO PLANNED Special DEVELOPMENT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That, as requested by Coastal Concepts, Inc. & First Pioneer Crp.in its application with supporting documents for zoning change, date July 3, , 198 7, and as amended on August 6 , 1987, (hereinafter, the Planned Special Development (AKA Solano Cay)

Application:), the zoning classification of the lands described on the attached Exhibit A is hereby changed from RG1 to Planned Special Development.

Section 2. That development of the lands within this <u>Planned Special Development</u> shall proceed in accordance with the <u>PSD (AKA Solano Cay)</u>
Application and supporting documents which are a part of zoning file <u>R-PSD-87-035</u> and which are incorporated by reference into and made a part of this ordinance, and as supplemented by the provisions of this ordinance. In the case of conflict between the Application or supporting documents and the below described provisions of this Ordinance, the below described provisions shall prevail.

Section 3. Fire Protection: Fire hydrants shall be provided within the PSD area and all fire protection requirements of St. Johns County will be met. This is indicated in the full set of horizontal construction documents on file with the County Engineer.

Section 4. Use of Undesignated Areas: These areas consist of retention lakes and open/undeveloped common areas as designated on the full set of horizontal construction documents on file with the County Engineer and will be used only for the purposes so designated.

Section 5. Height of Structures: The maximum height of structures shall be 35 feet.

Section 6. Standard Savings Clause: "All building code, zoning ordinance, and other land use and development regulations of St. Johns County as may be amended from time to time shall be applicable to this development except those permitting variances and special exceptions and except to the extent that they conflict with specific provisions of the approved development plan or PSD Ordinance. Modification to approved development plans by variance or special exception shall be prohibited."

Section 7. Accessory Uses and Structures Setbacks. Accessory uses and structures shall be separated from the main structure by not less than 10 feet; shall be located in the rear yard and shall not be less than 3 feet from any lot line.

Section 8. Time Schedule. Beginning June 1987, completion no later than July 1992.

Section 9. That all roads and parking areas within the project either public or private shall be constructed to approved County Standards.

Section 10. That all easements required for drainage purposes shall be granted to the County at no cost; at the Count's request.

Section 11. The Zoning Inspector is authorized to issue construction permits allowed by zoning classification as rezoned hereby.

Section 12. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment of the Office of the Secretary of State to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that the same has been filed.
