

ORDINANCE NUMBER 88-15

AN ORDINANCE OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, STATE OF FLORIDA AMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 87-44 BY ALLOWING THE DISPOSAL OF CERTAIN COMMUNITY TRASH AT THE TILLMAN RIDGE COUNTY LANDFILL WITHOUT CHARGE; PROVIDING DEFINITIONS; PROVIDING PROCEDURES AND LIMITATIONS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE:

WHEREAS certain non governmental community associations and business entities within St. Johns County promote and participate in local community cleanup days whereby the participants volunteer to pick up trash and other debris from the streets, sidewalks and utility easements within or near their communities for disposal at the County landfill or at other County trash disposal sites; and

WHEREAS the public at large benefits from the removal of trash and debris from such community areas

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA as follows:

Section 1. St. Johns County Ordinance 87-44 is hereby amended by adding the following Section 11 thereto:

Section 11. Community Trash

A. Community Service Organizations as defined herein may, not more than two (2) times each calender year per organization, Dispose of Community Trash, as defined herein, at the Tillman Ridge Landfill or at such other location(s) as the Board of County Commissioners of

office or employee the applicant is a Community Service Organization and that the trash and debris to be Disposed will consist solely of Community Trash.

B. Definitions, as used in this Section 11:

- i) Community Service Organization shall mean non governmental community associations and private business entities within St. Johns County, Florida that (i) promote and participate in local community cleanup days or projects located solely within St. Johns County and (ii) receive no pay or remuneration for such service.
- ii) Community Trash shall mean trash, refuse and debris, the origin of which is unknown or not readily ascertainable, that has fallen or collected upon the streets, rights of way, sidewalks and utility easements within or near the communities of St. Johns County
- iii) Disposal shall mean one or more free deliveries of Community Trash to St. Johns County garbage and trash dumping sites pursuant to this section within a 72 hour continuous time span.

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment by the Office of the Department of State, to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners that same has been filed.
