

ORDINANCE NO. 88-20

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR THE EXPANSION OF THE ANASTASIA MOSQUITO CONTROL DISTRICT TO INCLUDE PRECINCTS 11, 13, 23, 28, AND A PORTION OF 26; DIRECTING THE CLERK TO PUBLISH NOTICE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County has heretofore passed Resolution No. 88-6 which provided for an election of the registered electors residing within the Anastasia Mosquito Control District, and Precincts 11, 13, 23, 28 and a portion of 26, as described in the attached Exhibit "A", to determine by the majority of votes cast in the District, and the territory proposed to be annexed, whether the District should be enlarged; and

WHEREAS, the Election held in March of 1988 approved the expansion of the Anastasia Mosquito Control District to include said territory described in Exhibit "A" by a majority of the votes cast in each of the areas; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County finds that it is in the best interest of said territory described in Exhibit "A", and the existing District, to approve this expansion.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The territory of the Anastasia Mosquito Control District is hereby expanded to include the territory known as Precincts 11, 13, 23, 28, and a portion of 26, as described in the attached Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. The Clerk is hereby directed to publish a notice of the expanded boundaries of said District once each week for two successive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgement from the office of the Secretary of State to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida that same has been filed.

Beginning at the intersection of I-95 and the South line of Duval County where said intersection also being on the township line between Townships 4 and 5 South in Range 28 East; thence West along said township line to a point where township line intersects the range line between Ranges 27 and 28 East; thence North along said range line to where the same intersects Durbin Creek; thence West along the South bank of Durbin Creek to Julington Creek; thence continuing West along the thread of Julington Creek to the mouth thereof; thence due West to the West margin of the main channel of the St. Johns River and boundary line of Clay County; thence Southerly along the West margin of the main channel of said river to a point due West from the mouth of Mill Creek; thence due East along the waters of St. Johns River to the mouth of Mill Creek; thence Southeasterly along the center of Mill Creek to where the same intersects SR-13; thence Northerly along SR-13 to Ida Roberts Road; thence Southeasterly along Ida Roberts Road to where said road intersects a graded road running Easterly and lying approximately along the section line between Sections 8 and 17 in Township 5 South, Range 27 East; thence Easterly along said graded road to where the same intersects a graded road running Southerly; thence Southerly and Easterly along said graded road in Section 16, Township 5 South, Range 27 East, to where the same graded road intersects a graded road running Northeasterly; thence Northeasterly along said graded road in Section 15, Township 5 South, Range 27 East, to where the same graded road intersects a graded road running Southerly; thence Southerly along said graded road in Sections 15 and 22, Township 5 South, Range 27 East, to Bombing Range Road; thence Easterly along Bombing Range Road to CR-210; thence Easterly along CR-210 to I-95; thence Northerly along I-95 to the point of beginning.

Beginning at the intersection of CR-210 and SR-13 at Orangedale; thence Southeasterly along SR-13 to SR-16; thence West along SR-16 and along Shands Bridge to the West margin of the main channel of St. Johns River and boundary line of Clay County; thence Northerly along the West margin of the main channel of said river to a point due West from the mouth of Mill Creek; thence due East along the waters of St. Johns River to the mouth of Mill Creek; thence Southeasterly along the center of Mill Creek to where the same intersects SR-13; thence Northerly along SR-13 to Ida Roberts Road; thence Southeasterly along Ida Roberts Road to where said road intersects a graded road running Easterly and lying approximately along the section line between Sections 8 and 17 in Township 5 South, Range 27 East; thence Easterly along said graded road to where the same intersects a graded road running Southerly; thence Southerly and Easterly along said graded road in Section 16, Township 5 South, Range 27 East, to where the same graded road intersects a graded road running Northeasterly; thence Northeasterly along said graded road in Section 15, Township 5 South, Range 27 East, to where the same graded road intersects a graded road running Southerly; thence Southerly along said graded road in Sections 15 and 22, Township 5 South, Range 27 East, to Bombing Range Road; thence Easterly along Bombing Range Road to CR-210; thence Southwesterly along CR-210 to the point of beginning.

PRECINCT 28 (new)

Beginning at the intersection of U.S. #1 and the north limits of the City of St. Augustine; thence easterly and southerly along the north and east limits of said City of St. Augustine to the south line of Vilano causeway; thence easterly along Vilano causeway to the run of the Intracoastal Waterway; thence northerly following the run of the Intracoastal Waterway to Stokes Creek; thence westerly following the center of Stokes Creek to Stokes Road; thence southwesterly along Stokes Road to U.S. #1; thence southerly along U.S. #1 to the point of beginning.

Precinct 13, District 4, Revised

Voting Place: Allen D. Nassau School, Ray Road off U.S.#1 North

Beginning at the intersection of the Northerly boundary of St. Johns County and I-95; thence Southerly along I-95 to Nine Mile Road; thence Easterly and Northeasterly along Nine Mile Road to US #1; thence Southerly along US #1 to Stokes Road; thence Northeasterly along Stokes Road to Stokes Creek; thence Easterly following the center of Stokes Creek to the run of the Intracoastal Waterway; thence Northerly along the run of the Intracoastal Waterway to where the same intersects the township line between Townships 4 and 5 South; thence Westerly along said township line to the point of beginning.
