

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, AMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 84-61 WHICH IS THE ORDINANCE REQUIRING DOGS TO BE ON LEASHES IN CERTAIN SUBDIVISIONS WITHIN THE COUNTY; THIS AMENDMENT ADDS:

PORPOISE POINT SUBDIVISION AS RECORDED IN MAP BOOK 15 PAGES 1 THROUGH 9, OFFICIAL PUBLIC RECORDS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA AS A SUBDIVISION IN WHICH DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASHES; IT PROVIDES PENALTIES; AND PROVIDES AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. St. Johns County Ordinance No. 84-61, which is the ordinance described in the above title, is hereby amended by adding the following subdivision to the list of subdivisions contained in Section One of the ordinance.

Porpoise Point Subdivision as recorded in Map Book 15 pages 1 through 9, official public records of St. Johns County, Florida.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment by the Office of the Department of State to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that same has been filed.
