

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, DECLARING THAT AN EMERGENCY EXISTS AND AMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 72-6; THIS AMENDMENT DELETES SECTION 1 OF SAID ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO CERTAIN APPROPRIATIONS FOR ANIMAL CONTROL AND IT PROVIDES AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Due to the Health and Welfare benefits accruing to the citizens of St. Johns County by keeping the St. Johns County Humane Society Shelter for animals open, and the emergency that would befall the citizens of St. Johns County and the St. Johns County Humane Society if County appropriations for operation of the Humane Society Shelter should cease or be limited to \$2500.00 per year, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County hereby waives notice requirements for this emergency ordinance and declares that an emergency exists and that the immediate enactment of this ordinance is necessary.

Section 2. Section 1 of St. Johns County Ordinance No. 72-6 is hereby deleted, and shall be of no further effect.

Section 3. This ordinance is passed pursuant to Florida Statute 125.66(3) and shall take effect when a certified copy has been accepted by the postal authorities of the United States for special delivery by registered mail to the Department of State.
