

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, DECLARING THAT AN EMERGENCY EXISTS; REPEALING ST. JOHNS COUNTY RESOLUTION 85-184; ESTABLISHING THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY CRIMINAL JUSTICE TRAINING PROGRAM; ASSESSING \$2.00 COURT COSTS AS PROVIDED BY FLORIDA STATUTE 943.25(13)(1988); ESTABLISHING THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY SCHOOL CROSSING GUARD PROGRAM; DIRECTING THE MANNER IN WHICH MONIES RECEIVED BY THE COUNTY PURSUANT TO FLORIDA STATUTE 318.21(2)(1988) ARE TO BE SPENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Because of recent changes to Florida Statutes and to provide continued funding for school crossing guards and for criminal justice training the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, waives notice requirements for this emergency Ordinance and declares that an emergency exists and that the immediate enactment of this emergency ordinance is necessary.

Section 2. St. Johns County Resolution 85-184 is repealed.

Section 3. There is hereby established pursuant to Florida Statute 318.21(3)(c)(1988) and Florida Statute 943.25(13)(1988) the St. Johns County Criminal Justice Training Program. Pursuant to Florida Statute 943.25(13)(1988) St. Johns County hereby assesses an additional \$2.00 as court costs against those persons who are assessed under Florida Statute 943.25(3). Said \$2.00 shall be used for criminal justice education degree programs and training courses, including basic recruit training, for St. Johns County Sheriff's deputies and support personnel,

provided that such education degree programs and training courses are approved by the Sheriff, on a form provided by the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission, for local funding.

Section 4. There is hereby established pursuant to Florida Statute 318.21(3)(c)(1988) the St. Johns County School Crossing Guard Program. The Sheriff of St. Johns County shall administer said program.

Section 5. Monies paid to St. Johns County pursuant to subsection 2 of Florida Statute 318.21 (1988) shall be apportioned and used in the following manner:

20 % shall be used to help fund the St. Johns County Criminal Justice Training Program.


35 % shall be used to help fund the St. Johns County School Crossing Guard Program.

45 % shall be deposited into the general fund of St. Johns County to be used for any lawful purpose.

Section 6. This Ordinance is passed pursuant to Florida Statute 125.66(3) and shall take effect when a certified copy has been accepted by the postal authorities of the United States for special delivery by registered mail to the Department of State.


