

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CLERK
OF THE COURT TO SUPPLY THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF
HIGHWAY SAFETY AND MOTOR VEHICLES WITH A LIST OF
PERSONS WITH OUTSTANDING PARKING VIOLATIONS.

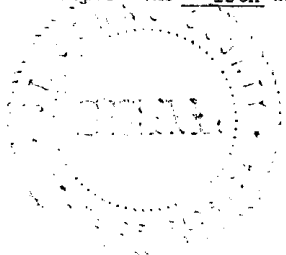
Section 1: Florida Statutes Chapter 316 is the State Uniform Traffic Control Law which authorizes the issuance of parking tickets for parking violations.

Section 2: Florida Statute 316.1967(6) states that any county may provide by ordinance that the Clerk of the Court or the Traffic Violations Bureau shall supply the tax collector and license tag agents within said county, monthly, with an alphabetized list of persons who have five or more outstanding parking violations. The provisions of s. 320.03(8) shall apply to each person whose name appears on such list.

Section 3: House Bill 734 amends Section 316.1967(6) Florida Statutes as follows: "Any county may provide by ordinance that the Clerk of the Court or the Traffic Violations Bureau shall supply the department with a magnetically encoded computer tape reel or cartridge which is machine readable by the installed computer system at the department, listing persons who have three or more outstanding parking violations. The department shall mark the appropriate registration records of persons so reported. The provisions of s. 320.03(8) shall apply to each person whose name appears on such list."

Section 4: Now Therefore Be It Ordained by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that pursuant to Florida Statute 316.1967(6) as amended, the Clerk of the Court is authorized to supply the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles with a magnetically encoded computer tape reel or cartridge which is machine readable by the installed computer system at the department, listing persons who have had three or more outstanding parking violations.
