

AN ORDINANCE OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA AMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE #90-10, THE "ST. JOHNS COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR ORDINANCE." THIS AMENDMENT AUTHORIZES THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AND OTHER AGREEMENTS AND TO DELEGATE HIS POWERS TO OTHER COUNTY EMPLOYEES OPERATING UNDER HIS DIRECTION AND CONTROL; AND IT PROVIDES AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA.

Section 1. St. Johns County ordinance #90-10 is hereby amended by adding the following subparagraphs to paragraph 1 of Section 5 thereof:

(v) Negotiate and execute contracts, leases, purchase orders, and other agreements, including consulting services, for the Board pursuant to procedures authorized or approved by the Board.

(w) Delegate any of the powers set forth in paragraph 1 of Section 5 to County employees operating under the direction and control of the County Administrator.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgement by the Office of the Department of State to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners that same has been filed.

JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AT ITS REGULAR MEETING ON TUESDAY, JULY 10, 1990, AT 10:15 O'CLOCK A.M. IN THE COUNTY AUDITORIUM, COUNTY ADMINISTRATION BUILDING, LEWIS SPEEDWAY (COUNTY ROAD 16-A) AND U.S. #1 NORTH, ST. AUGUSTINE, FLORIDA, WILL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER THE PASSAGE OF THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE: AN ORDINANCE OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA AMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE #90-10, THE "ST.
