

AN ORDINANCE OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE COUNTY CODE THAT REGULATES THE SALE, SERVICE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, INCLUDING BEER, MALT BEVERAGES, WINES AND LIQUOR, BY PERSONS AND ENTITIES HOLDING A STATE BEVERAGE LICENSE. THIS AMENDMENT CLARIFIES THE CODE'S INTENT TO REGULATE "BOTTLE CLUBS"; IT ADVANCES THE TIMES IN WHICH BEER, MALT BEVERAGES AND WINE MAY BE SOLD FOR OFF PREMISES CONSUMPTION FROM 7:00 A.M. TO 6:00 A.M.; AND IT PROVIDES AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Whereas, St. Johns County Code section 3-1 is currently worded in such a manner that it is uncertain whether the consumption, as well as the sale, of alcoholic beverages is regulated by such section; and

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida wishes to confirm its intent to regulate such consumption.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA that Section 3-1 of the St. Johns County Code is hereby amended and re-enacted as follows:

(a) Beer, malt beverages, and wines, as defined in section 561.01, Florida Statutes, as amended, may be sold for off premise consumption in any place holding a valid license from the state beverage department between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 1:00 a.m. of the following day on each day, including Sundays and may be sold, served or consumed in any place holding a valid license from the state beverage department between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 1:00 a.m. of the following day on each day, including Sundays.

(b) Liquors, as defined in section 561.01, Florida Statutes as amended, may be sold, served or consumed in any place holding a valid license from the state beverage department between the hours of 7:00 a.m. of one day and 1:00 a.m. of the following day; provided, however, that the sale of such liquors on Sunday shall be from 1:00 p.m. to 1:00 a.m. of the following Monday.

(c) It shall be unlawful for any person or entity holding a state beverage license, or his agent to sell or serve, or permit to be sold, served or consumed, any alcoholic beverages in any place holding a valid license from the state beverage department except as provided in subsections a) or b) above.

(d) In the event of a conflict between subsections (a) or (b) above and any zoning regulation, the zoning regulation shall prevail.

Effective Date: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment by the Office of the Department of State to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners that same has been filed.

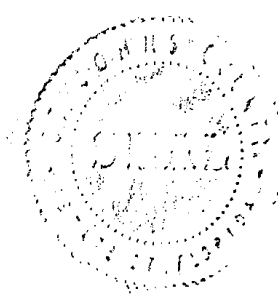
