

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA AMENDING ORDINANCE # 88-42 WHICH IS AN ORDINANCE THAT REGULATES CONTROL OF DOGS AND CATS WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY. THIS AMENDMENT PROVIDES CERTAIN TIME LIMITS IN WHICH IMPOUNDED DOGS AND CATS SHALL BE DESTROYED OR OTHERWISE DISPOSED OF; IT PROVIDES FOR FUTURE CHANGES IN THE ORDINANCE TO BE MADE BY RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS; AND PROVIDES AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. St. Johns County Ordinance #88-42 is hereby amended by changing Section 5D thereto:

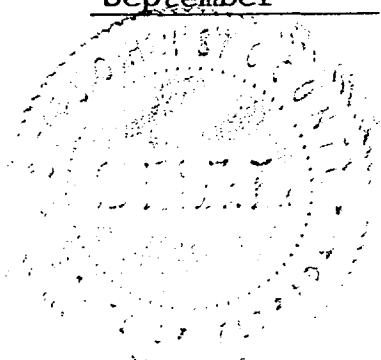
Section 5D. Any dog or cat impounded by the Animal Control Officer or at his direction that is not claimed by, and returned to, its owner within five (5) days of its impoundment may be destroyed or otherwise disposed of without compensation to the owner.

Section 2. St. Johns County Ordinance #88-42 is hereby amended by adding the following Section 5 F thereto:

Section 5F. The terms and conditions required by this ordinance may be modified by future resolution(s) of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment by the Office of the Department of State to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners that same has been filed.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AT ITS REGULAR MEETING ON TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 25, 1990, AT 11:30 O'CLOCK A.M. IN THE COUNTY AUDITORIUM, COUNTY ADMINISTRATION BUILDING, 4020 LEWIS SPEEDWAY (COUNTY ROAD 16-A) AND U.S. #1 NORTH, ST. AUGUSTINE, FLORIDA, WILL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER THE PASSAGE OF THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE:

The proposed Ordinance is on file in the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court, St. Johns County, Florida, St. Johns County Administration Building, Lewis Speedway, and may be examined by parties interested prior to said public hearing.
All parties having any interest in said Ordinance will be afforded an opportunity to be heard at the public hearing.
If a person decides to appeal any decision made by the Board of County Commissioners with respect to any matter considered at the meeting or hearing, he will need a record of the proceedings, and for such purposes he may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
