BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. St. Johns County Ordinance #88-42 is hereby amended by changing Section 5D thereto:

Section 5D. Any dog or cat impounded by the Animal Control Officer or at his direction that is not claimed by, and returned to, its owner within <u>five</u> (5) <u>days</u> of its impoundment may be destroyed or otherwise disposed of without compensation to the owner.

Section 2. St. Johns County Ordinance #88-42 is hereby amended by adding the following Section 5 F thereto:

Section 5F. The terms and conditions required by this ordinance may be modified by future resolution(s) of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment by the Office of the Department of State to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners that same has been filed.
