

ORDINANCE NUMBER 90- 62

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA. THIS ORDINANCE AMENDS ORDINANCE 90-9, THE COUNTY SIGN ORDINANCE, BY ADDING TO ARTICLE I AND ARTICLE II CERTAIN EXEMPTIONS AND REGULATIONS FOR SIGNS ON APPROVED SCHOOL BUS STOP SHELTERS THAT ARE LOCATED UPON CERTAIN RIGHT OF WAYS WITHIN THE COUNTY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

St. Johns County ordinance number 90-9 is hereby amended in the following manner:

1. Article I, Section IX. shall have added to it the following subsection f):

f) School Bus Stop Shelter Signs: Any sign located on a school bus stop shelter located on a County or other right-of-way pursuant to authority granted by County resolution(s) shall be exempt from the provisions of Article I of this ordinance with the exception of the provisions contained or described in this subsection f. No prohibited sign described in subsections b, c, d, e, f, g, i, k, and l of section VIII and no political, religious, tobacco or alcohol sign shall be placed upon any school bus stop shelter. The location of signage upon any school bus stop shelter shall not have any effect upon the set back or space requirements between off site signs nor shall they effect the location, shape, size, space or other requirements of this Article I as it pertains to other signs. No electric or animated signs may be placed on school bus stop shelters. All signs on school bus stop shelters shall be painted thereon or fastened firmly thereto in such a manner that no part protrudes more than 3 inches from the shelter. No signage on a school bus stop shelter shall have a combined sign area greater than (4,400) four thousand four hundred square inches per side or face of the school bus stop shelter. School bus stop shelters are limited to only utilizing for advertising purposes 2 sides or faces.

2. Article II, Section G shall have added to it the following subsection 18:

18. School Bus Stop Shelter Signs: Any sign located on a school bus stop shelter located on a County or other right-of-way pursuant to authority granted by County resolution(s) shall be exempt from the provisions of Article II of this ordinance with the exception of the provisions contained in this subsection 18. No political, religious, obscene, tobacco, or alcohol signs shall be placed upon any school bus stop shelter. The location of signage upon any school bus stop shelter shall not have any effect upon the location, shape, size, space or other requirements of this Article II as it pertains to other signs. No electric or animated signs may be placed on school bus stop shelters. All signs on school bus stop shelters shall be painted thereon or fastened firmly thereto in such a manner that no part protrudes more than 3 inches from the shelter. No signage on a school bus stop shelter shall have a combined sign area greater than (4,400) four thousand four hundred square inches per side or face of the school bus stop shelter. School bus stop shelters are limited to only utilizing for advertising purposes 2 sides or faces.

3. Subsection 3 of section F of Article II is deleted and the following is added and substituted in its stead:

3. No Off-site Commercial Sign shall be permitted in the Corridor except for signs located on school bus stop shelters in the manner set forth in subsection 18 of section G below.

4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment by the Office of the Department of State, to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners that same has been filed.
