AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, CONFIRMING A PREVIOUS COUNTY RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO THE SUBJECT MATTER OF THIS ORDINANCE; MAKING FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS CONCERNING THE EXISTANCE AND REHABILITATION OF SLUMS OR BLIGHTED AREAS WITHIN ST. JOHNS COUNTY; FINDING A NEED FOR AND CREATING A PUBLIC BODY CORPORATE AND POLITIC TO BE KNOWN AS THE ST. JOHNS COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT COUNTY PROVIDING FOR LIBERALITY OF CONSTRUCTION SEVERABILITY; APPOINTING MEMBERS AND FOR TO THE AGENCY; APPOINTING A CHAIRMAN AND VICE CHAIRMAN; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA.

Section 1. Each section of St. Johns County Resolution #90-201 is hereby ratified and approved.

Section 2. It is hereby found, determined and declared that:

- There exists in St. Johns County many old and inadequate subdivisions that were recorded prior to the enactment of the County's subdivision regulations and that contain lots whose sizes are inadequate for sound and safe residential development, that contain poor or inadequate rights of ways for streets, utilities and drainage, that contain no mechanism for construction of necessary roads and drainage facilities; that contain lots owned by such diversity of ownership that coordinated planning is impracticable if not impossible, that contain one or more of the characteristics of a blighted area as determined by the Florida legislature in Part III Chapter 163 Florida Statutes and that substantially impair or arrest the sound growth of the county and constitute a menace to the public health, safety, morals or welfare in their present condition and use; and
- b) One or more slum or blighted areas, or one or more areas in which there is a shortage of housing affordable to residents of low or moderate income, including the elderly, exist in St. Johns County; and
- c) The rehabilitation, conservation, or redevelopment, or a combination thereof, of such area or areas is necessary in the interest of the public health, safety, morals, or welfare of the redidents of St. Johns County; and
- d) There is a need for a community redevelopment agency to function in St. Johns County to carry out the community redevelopment purposes of Part III of Chapter 163 Florida Statutes; and
- e) All Notices required by Florida Statute 163.346 pertaining to this Ordinance have been provided.

Section 3. There is hereby created a public body corporate and politic to be known as the St. Johns County Community Redevelopment Agency which shall be and shall constitute a Florida Statute 163.356 community redevelopment agency.

Section 4. The powers of the St. Johns County Community Redevelopment Agency shall be exercised by its board of commissioners which shall consist of not fewer than five or more than seven commissioners. The terms of office of the commissioners shall be for 4 years, except that three of the members first approinted shall be designated to serve terms of 1, 2, and 3 years, respectively, from the date of their appointments, and all other members shall be designated to serve for terms of 4 years from the date of their appointments.

Section 5. The following persons reside or are engaged in a business (in the manner set forth in Florida Statute 163.356(3)(b)) within the area of operation of the Agency and are hereby appointed to the board of commissioners of the St. Johns County Community Redevelopment Agency for the terms indicated next to their names:

Each Commissioner shall hold office until his successor has been appointed and has qualified. Each member of this Agency shall take and subscribe the oath or affirmation required by the State constitution.

Section 6. <u>John Lester</u> shall be the initial

Section 7. A certificate of the appointment or reappointment
of each commissioner shall be filed with the clerk of the county.
Section 8. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be liberally
construed to effectively carry out its intent and purpose. If any
section, phrase, sentence or portion of this Ordinance is for any
reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent
jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct
and independent provision and such holdings shall not effect the
validity of the remaining provisions hereof.
