

AN ORDINANCE OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA REQUIRING THE CLERK OF COURTS OR TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS BUREAU TO PERFORM CERTAIN DUTIES PERTAINING TO VIOLATIONS OF FLORIDA STATUTES 316.1955 AND 316.1956 AND SIMILAR ORDINANCES REGULATING PARKING IN SPACES DESIGNATED FOR USE BY DISABLED PERSONS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

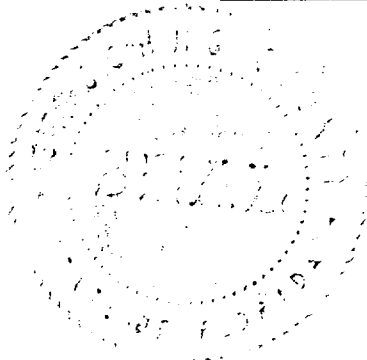
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA as follows:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida hereby finds and determines that the Florida legislature, through passage of Chapter 90-48 (CS for SB 502), directed the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County to enact an ordinance containing the provisions in Section 2 below.

Section 2. The Clerk of the Court or the Traffic Violations Bureau for St. Johns County shall supply the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles with a magnetically encoded computer tape reel or cartridge which is machine readable by the installed computer system at the Department, listing persons who have any outstanding violations of s. 316.1955, s. 316.1956, or any similar local ordinance regulating parking in spaces designated for use by disabled persons wherein such violations were committed on or after October 1, 1990.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment by the office of the Department of State to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that same has been filed.
