

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE #76-5, AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED, WHICH CREATES THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY PLANNING AND ZONING AGENCY, ESTABLISHES PROCEDURES FOR APPOINTING MEMBERS AND THEIR TERM OF OFFICE, AND SPECIFIES THE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES THEREOF. THIS AMENDMENT REQUIRES THAT ANY PERSON APPOINTED OR REAPPOINTED TO THE PLANNING AND ZONING AGENCY MUST SUBMIT HIS OR HER RESUME' TO THE COUNTY PRIOR TO THE APPOINTMENT; IT REQUIRES THE COUNTY TO ADVERTISE FOR APPLICATIONS WITH RESUMES FROM PERSONS DESIRING TO BECOME MEMBERS OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING AGENCY; IT PROVIDES THAT MEMBERS TERMS OF OFFICE WILL EXPIRE ON DECEMBER 1 OF THE YEAR IN WHICH THE TERM WAS ORIGINALLY, OR IS HEREAFTER, SCHEDULED TO EXPIRE;

IT REQUIRES THAT NEW MEMBERS BE APPOINTED TO THE PLANNING AND ZONING AGENCY ON THE BASIS OF QUALIFICATIONS BUT IN SUCH A MANNER THAT NO SINGLE MEMBER COUNTY COMMISSION DISTRICT WILL HAVE WITHIN ITS BOUNDARIES THE RESIDENCES OF A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING AGENCY; AND IT PROVIDES AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. St. Johns County ordinance #76-5, as previously amended, is hereby amended by adding the following section 6 thereto:

Section 6. Any person hereafter appointed or reappointed to the St. Johns County Planning And Zoning Agency must submit his or her resume' to the County prior to the appointment.

Section 2. St. Johns County ordinance #76-5, as previously amended, is hereby amended by adding the following section 7 thereto:

Section 7. The County shall advertise once each year for applications with resumes from persons desiring to become members of the St. Johns County Planning And Zoning Agency.

Section 3. St. Johns County ordinance #76-5, as previously amended, is hereby amended by adding the following section 8 thereto:

Section 8. Notwithstanding any other provision contained within St. Johns County ordinance #76-5 as amended, commencing immediately, the terms of each existing member of the St. Johns County Planning And Zoning Agency shall expire on December 1 of the year in which such members term was originally scheduled to expire. Thereafter, the terms of each member of the St. Johns County Planning And Zoning Agency shall be scheduled to expire on December 1st of appropriate year(s).

Section 4. St. Johns County ordinance #76-5, as previously amended, is hereby amended by adding the following section 9 thereto:


Section 5. St. Johns County ordinance #76-5, as previously amended, is hereby amended by adding the following section 10 thereto:

Section 10. New members to the St. Johns County Planning And Zoning Agency shall be appointed on the basis of qualifications but in such a manner that no single member county commission district will have within its boundaries the residences of a majority of the members of the St. Johns County Planning And Zoning Agency.



REQUIRES THAT ANY PERSON

TO THE PLANNING AND ZONING  
AGENCY MUST SUBMIT HIS OR  
HER RESUME TO THE COUNTY  
PRIOR TO THE APPOINTMENT.  
IT REQUIRES THE COUNTY TO  
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DESIRING TO BECOME MEMBERS  
OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING  
AGENCY; IT PROVIDES THAT  
MEMBERS TERMS OF OFFICE  
WILL EXPIRE ON DECEMBER 1  
OF THE YEAR IN WHICH THE  
TERM WAS ORIGINALLY OR IS  
HEREAFTER SCHEDULED TO  
EXPIRE; IT PROHIBITS ANY  
PERSONS FROM BEING APPOINTED  
TO MORE THAN CONSECUTIVE  
FULL TERMS AS A MEMBER OF  
THE PLANNING AND ZONING  
AGENCY; IT REQUIRES THAT  
NEW MEMBERS BE APPOINTED  
TO THE PLANNING AND ZONING  
AGENCY ON THE BASIS OF  
QUALIFICATIONS BUT IN SUCH  
A MANNER THAT NO SINGLE  
MEMBER COUNTY COMMISSION  
DISTRICT WILL HAVE WITHIN  
ITS BOUNDARIES THE RESIDENCES  
OF A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS  
OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING  
AGENCY; AND IT PROVIDES AN  
EFFECTIVE DATE.

The proposed Ordinance is on file in the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court, St. Johns County, Florida, St. Johns County Administration Building, Lewis Speedway, and may be examined by parties interested prior to said public hearing.

All parties having any interest in said Ordinance will be afforded an opportunity to be heard at the public hearing.

If a person decides to appeal any decision made by the Board of County Commissioners with respect to any matter considered at the meeting or hearing, he will need a record of the proceedings, and for such purposes he may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
