

ORDINANCE No. 91- 31

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, DECLARING THAT AN EMERGENCY EXISTS AND AMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 90-10, AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED, THE "ST. JOHNS COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR ORDINANCE." THIS AMENDMENT MODIFIES THE TERM AND RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS FOR THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR'S EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT AND PROVIDES AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, concurring with the advice of the St. Johns County Citizens Charter Government Study Committee, deems it advisable and necessary that the County Administrator's employment contract expire on November 30th of off election years; and

WHEREAS, the Board and the Board's top choice for the vacant St. Johns County administrator position have agreed upon the terms of an employment contract; and

WHEREAS, both the Board and the applicant deem it necessary that the contract, which incorporates a "two year" employment term, be executed within the week to enable the vacant position of County Administrator to be filled at the earliest possible moment during the current County budget process

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

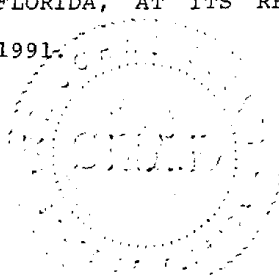
Section 1. In order to allow the County to timely employ a County Administrator to a "two year" term during the current County budget process, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, waives notice requirements for this emergency ordinance and declares that an emergency exists and that the immediate enactment of this emergency ordinance is necessary.

Section 2. St. Johns County ordinance #90-10, as previously amended, is hereby amended by deleting subparagraph (d) from Section 4 thereof and by adding and substituting the following therefor;

(d) COMPENSATION: The compensation of the County Administrator shall be fixed by the Board of County Commissioners unless otherwise provided by law. The County Administrator shall be hired on a contract basis only which contract will be automatically renewed on November 30th of each odd (non election) year unless such renewal is opposed by a majority vote of the membership of the Board of County Commissioners in the manner to be provided in the employment contract.

Section 3. This Ordinance is passed pursuant to Florida Statute 125.66(3) and shall take effect when a certified copy has been accepted by the postal authorities of the United States for special delivery by registered mail to the Florida Department of State.
