

ORDINANCE NUMBER : 91 - 39

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, AMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 89-52. THIS AMENDMENT MODIFIES THE AMOUNT OF MONEY RECEIVED PURSUANT TO FLORIDA STATUTE §318.21(2)(g)2 THAT WILL BE USED TO FUND THE COUNTY'S CRIMINAL JUSTICE TRAINING PROGRAM AND THE COUNTY'S SCHOOL CROSSING GUARD PROGRAM; AND PROVIDES AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. St. Johns County Ordinance No. 89-52 is hereby amended by deleting the existing Section 5 and by adding the following in its stead:

Section 5. Monies paid to St. Johns County pursuant to subparagraph (2)(g)2 of Florida Statute §318.21 shall be apportioned and used in the following manner:

35% shall be used to help fund the St. Johns County Criminal Justice Training Program.

20% shall be used to help fund the St. Johns County School Crossing Guard Program.

45% shall be deposited into the general fund of St. Johns County to be used for any lawful purpose

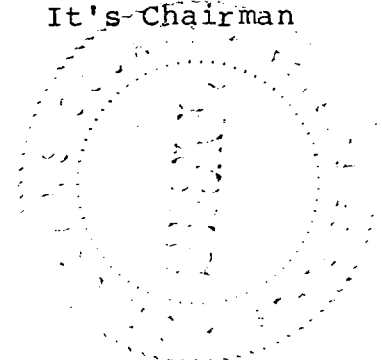
Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment by the Office of the Department of State to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that same has been filed.
