

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, AMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 76-20, WHICH PROVIDES FOR THE REGISTRATION, EXAMINATION, AND CERTIFICATION OF COUNTY LICENSED CONTRACTORS; AMENDING SEC. 6-76(d), CHAPTER 6, ARTICLE V, OF THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY CODE, KNOWN AS REGULATION OF CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTORS; REPEALING ORDINANCE 80-25; PROVIDING FOR ADJUSTMENT OF FEES FOR EXAMINATION FOR CERTIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. Paragraph (F) of Section VI, St. Johns County Ordinance 76-20, as amended, is hereby amended by deleting it in its entirety and substituting the following in its stead:

- F. Application for any license examination as herein provided shall be made to the St. Johns County Building Department (Building Department) in writing on forms furnished by the Building Department, and shall be accompanied by an application fee of \$50.00. NOTICE: In addition to the application fees paid to St. Johns County, outside testing agencies may charge fees for administering the license examination and may require payment of these fees directly to them prior to administration of the test.

Applicants for any "Journeyman" designation shall submit verifiable written evidence that they have had a minimum of two years experience or education in the field for which certification is being sought. Two years experience shall be experience gained through working as an apprentice or helper in the appropriate trade for two years; or one year of education in a recognized accredited college or vocational school plus one year of manual experience in the applicable electrical, plumbing, mechanical, heating, air conditioning or refrigeration construction trade.

SECTION 2. Paragraph (J) of Section VI, St. Johns County Ordinance 76-20, as amended, is hereby amended by deleting it in its entirety and substituting the following in its

stead:

All applications for any examination must be filed with the Building Department not less than four (4) weeks prior to the date of the examination.

SECTION 3. Ordinance 80-25 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. Article V of Chapter 6 of the St. Johns County Code is hereby amended by deleting Sec. 6-76(d) in its entirety, and substituting Sections 1 and 2 of this ordinance in its stead.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon receipt of official acknowledgement by the Office of the Secretary of State to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that same has been filed.
