

ORDINANCE NO. 93- 39

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, AMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 89-52 AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED. THIS AMENDMENT MODIFIES THE AMOUNT OF MONEY RECEIVED PURSUANT TO FLORIDA STATUTE SECTION 318.21(2)(g)2 THAT WILL BE USED TO FUND THE COUNTY'S CRIMINAL JUSTICE TRAINING PROGRAM AND THE COUNTY'S SCHOOL CROSSING GUARD PROGRAM; IT ALLOWS FUTURE MODIFICATIONS TO BE DONE BY RESOLUTION(S); AND IT PROVIDES AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. St. Johns County Ordinance No. 89-52 as previously amended is hereby amended by deleting the existing Section 5 and by adding the following in its stead:

Section 5. Monies paid to St. Johns County pursuant to subparagraph (2)(g)2 of Florida Statutes Section 318.21 shall be apportioned and used in the following manner:

45% shall be used to help fund the St. Johns County Criminal Justice Training Program.

15% shall be used to help fund the St. Johns County School Crossing Guard Program.

40% shall be deposited into the general fund of St. Johns County to be used for any lawful purpose.

Section 2. St. Johns County Ordinance No. 89-52 as previously amended is hereby amended by adding the following section 7 thereto:

Section 7. Future modifications to the percentages set forth in section 5 may be made by resolution(s) of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment by the Office of the Department of State to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that same has been filed.

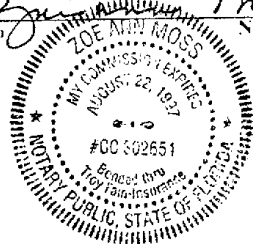
