

ORDINANCE NO. 94- 48

AN ORDINANCE OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA RATIFYING, CONFIRMING, DESIGNATING AND ESTABLISHING THAT THE DULY ELECTED AND CURRENT SHERIFF OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY IS AND SHALL BE THE CHIEF CORRECTION OFFICER OF THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY CORRECTIONAL SYSTEM; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the duly elected Sheriff of St. Johns County has continuously served as the Chief Correctional Officer of St. Johns County since prior to 1968; and

WHEREAS, neither the St. Johns County Sheriff's office, the St. Johns County Clerk of Courts, nor the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County have been able to locate documentation expressly designating the Sheriff of St. Johns County as Chief Correctional Officer of St. Johns County; and

WHEREAS, sections 951.06 and/or 951.07 Florida Statutes, require the Board of County Commissioners to designate a Chief Correctional Officer for the county correctional system and authorize the Board of County Commissioners to appoint the Sheriff as such Chief Correctional Officer with the salaries for county correctional officers to be paid from the general revenue fund of the county and included in the Sheriff's budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County hereby ratifies, confirms, designates and establishes that the duly elected and current Sheriff of St. Johns County is and shall be the Chief Correctional Officer of St. Johns County, Florida and he or she shall appoint such correctional officers as he or she deems necessary and as are required by rule of the Florida Department of Corrections.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt by the Clerk of official acknowledgment from the Department of State that same has been filed.

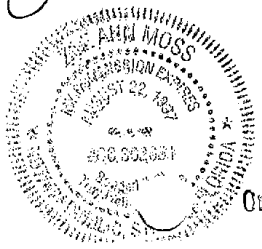
