

ORDINANCE NO. 96- 71

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA AMENDING ORDINANCE 86-62, AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED, WHICH IS THE ORDINANCE THAT AMONG OTHER THINGS ESTABLISHES THE MEMBERS OF THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY TOURIST DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL. THIS ORDINANCE AMENDS THE PROVISION CONCERNING THE APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS TO THE COUNCIL, AND IT PROVIDES AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida (the "Board") wishes to conform the power of the Board to appoint members of the Tourist Development Council to Section 125.0104(4)(e) Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Section 125.0104(4)(e) Florida statutes has recently been amended by the Florida Legislature.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA as follows:

Section 1. St. Johns County Ordinance 86-62, as previously amended, is hereby amended by deleting the first paragraph from Section 2 thereof and by adding and substituting the following first paragraph in its stead:

SECTION 2. TOURIST DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL. There is hereby continued pursuant to the provisions of 125.0104 Florida Statutes an advisory council to be known as the "St. Johns County Tourist Development Council", hereinafter referred to as "Council". The Council shall be composed of nine (9) members. One member of the Council shall be the current chair of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida (the "Board") or such other member of the Board as the chair of the Board shall designate. Two members of the Council shall be elected municipal officials, at least one of whom shall be from the most populous municipality in the county or subcounty special taxing district in which the tax is levied. Six members of the Council shall be persons who are involved in the tourist industry and who have demonstrated an interest in tourist development, of which members, not less than three nor more than four shall be owners or operators of motels, hotels, recreational vehicle parks, or other tourist accommodations in the county and subject to the tax. All members of the council shall be electors of the county. The Board shall have the option of designating the

chairperson of the Council or allowing the Council to elect a chairperson. A chairperson shall be appointed or elected annually and may be reelected or reappointed.


Section 2. The changes to the first paragraph of Section 2 of Ordinance 86-62, as previously amended, accomplished by Section 1 above shall not be deemed to require a change to the existing membership of the council, but shall instead affect any new appointments or potential reappointments.

Section 3. St. Johns County Ordinance 86-62 and Resolution 86-62, which were passed together as an integrated writing on July 8, 1986, are referred to as "Ordinance 86-62" for the purposes of this amending ordinance.


Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon receipt by the Secretary of State.

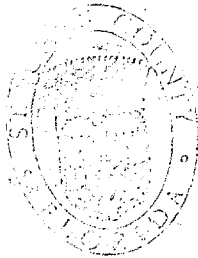

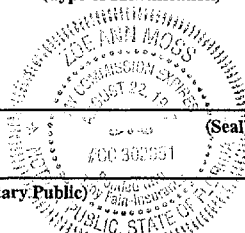
